



2020-2021 Gifted Endorsement Online Courses Schedule

The eLearning Network at the North East Florida Educational Consortium (NEFEC) is proud to offer online Gifted Endorsement courses. The Gifted Endorsement is designed to increase the level of knowledge, expertise, and understanding of educators working with students who are gifted. The endorsement is intended to raise the awareness of the unique characteristics, emotional/social needs, and other challenges associated with students who are gifted. The courses were designed to foster an understanding of historical, state and national trends, policies, and guidelines to ensure implementation of appropriate academic curriculum, differentiation strategies, educational interventions, and support for this diverse population.

Each online gifted endorsement course is 8 weeks long. The courses offer flexibility to work at your convenience during the 8 weeks, are completely online, and require no face-to-face meetings or specific dates/times required to be online.

The gifted endorsement courses can be taken in any order.

The fee for each Gifted Endorsement course is \$165.00 for NEFEC Districts and \$300.00 for non-NEFEC Districts.
